Bank Account Fraud—URGENT

A client has received a fake letter today by fax claiming to be from Safcor Panalpina advising of a change in our banking details and enclosing a fake blank cheque to "confirm " this.

We have not changed our banking details and have no intention of doing so.

The letter is fraudulent and is intended to steal money from clients by diverting their payments to us. The matter is being investigated and is in the process of being reported to the relevant authorities.

Clients who wish to confirm that they have our correct account details should contact the credit controller at their nearest Safcor Panalpina office.

IF YOU ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING PAYMENTS TO SAFCOR PANALPINA WE REQUEST THAT YOU URGENTLY FORWARD THIS COMMUNIQUE TO THE ACCOUNTANT/FINANCIAL MANAGER/ FINANCIAL DIRECTOR OF YOUR BUSINESS UNIT.
