Understanding CPC Codes : Invitation

The use of customs procedure codes (CPCs) for all customs clearances becomes mandatory on 1st November. This initiative forms part of the first phase of SARS' modernisation programme, which will culminate in the introduction of a new Customs Act early in the New Year.

Clients' clearing instructions will in future have to include details of the customs procedure under which cargo is to be declared. A revised instruction form will be distributed shortly and information sessions for clients explaining what the permissible procedures are and how the codes are to be used have been held country-wide by Safcor Panalpina offices.
