CARGO HANDLING CHARGES RISE

Portnet, Transnet and ACSA will all be implementing annual increases in their tariff structures on 1st April. These costs directly affect Safcor Panalpina's degroup and cargo handling operations for both seafreight and airfreight. As a result our tariffs for these services are being revised to incorporate these changes. The revised tariffs come into effect for all shipments handled on or after 1st April 2011. Copies of the revised rates may be obtained from your Safcor Panalpina Client Services representative.

TERMINAL CLOSURES

Transnet has given notice that Durban's terminal will be temporarily closed on the weekend of 26th/27th March in order to switch the port to NAVIS, Portnet's new integrated container tracking and management system. This system is already used at other ports and the terminals at Ngqura, Port Elizabeth and Cape Town will be closed from 18h00 on 26th March to 06h00 on Sunday 27th March to allow systems to be integrated and tested.

If difficulties are encountered in implementing the new system, delays in the movements of containers at Durban may ensue.
