Customs Procedure Code Seminars - Gauteng

The use of Customs Procedure Codes becomes mandatory for all clearances from the end of this month. At the same time declarations will have to show whether goods are new, used or second-hand and if the importer intends claiming VAT paid to SARS on importation as a tax input.

Customs Legislation makes the importer responsible for including this information in clearing instructions: agents are not permitted to complete or issue these instructions on behalf of their clients.
