Diesel supplies in Durban are reported to be dwindling as a result of the chemical workers' strike. Clients are warned that any prolonged shortage will restrict the ability of cartage contractors to collect and deliver containers, particularly to inland destinations such as Gauteng.

Storage/demurrage and/or penalty charges imposed by Transnet or other parties as the result of hauliers' inability to uplift/deliver/return containers will be for the account of the cargo.
