### Durban Congestion Update

Transnet's IT system malfunctioned this morning. As a result, vehicles are unable to access the Durban Container Terminal to either deliver or collect containers. It is understood that this system failure may also be affecting facilities elsewhere in the country.

We have also been advised that the Maersk Drury v 1105 is to omit both Cape Town and Port Louis. Cape Town import cargo is to be transhipped to the Maersk Denver at Port Elizabeth, while exports from Cape Town and cargo for Mauritius will be held over for the Maersk Denver v 1107.
