Durban Congestion Update

Minimal activity at the Durban Container Terminal because of yesterday's public holiday has pushed stack occupancy within the facility to 89% of capacity.

As a result, vehicle turn around times have increased substantially and are currently estimated at about six hours.

It is expected that the backlog will take at least a week to clear provided that operations continue without any further disruptions.

Delays may also be expected at other South African ports if shipping lines adjust schedules to accommodate Durban's delays.
