Durban Congestion Update

Durban's container terminal has been windbound since shortly after 08h00 today as the city experiences cold and wet conditions with a strong southerly wind. This follows similar stoppages in the past three days totaling 22 hours, all of which have added to the congestion and chaos being experienced at the port. There has been no material change in the rates of collection or delivery at Durban and it is becoming difficult to source transport capacity at short notice.
