### 1. Durban Container Terminal

Durban's Container Terminal (DCT) is functioning at a snail's pace and no official explanations can be obtained to explain the problem.

Between 300 and 400 trucks are currently waiting to enter the terminal to collect/deliver cargo and an unknown number of vehicles are queued within the facility.

Safcor Panalpina has four vehicles that joined the queue at 6pm last night, two of which were to collect containers for overnight delivery to Gauteng. These are still waiting for permission to enter the terminal.

Reports from other hauliers indicate that they too have drivers who have spent the entire night or longer waiting in the queue to enter the terminal.
