Durban Delays Update

Long queues and extensive delays are again occurring at Durban. In the past few days the port has experienced power and communications failures, while Pier 2 is reported to be windbound once again.

The position is extremely serious with carriers waiting for many hours to enter the harbour to collect cargo. Efforts by desperate importers to change carriers/transport modes at the last minute are exacerbating the problems and are usually futile.

Safcor Panalpina will continue to monitor the situation and to engage with interested parties in seeking possible solutions.
