Durban Terminal Delays and Japan Update

Durban Terminal Delays

Currently there are delays in collecting containers from Durban Container Terminal and Pier 2, as a result of the switchover to NAVIS last weekend. NAVIS is Portnet's new integrated container tracking and management system. It is taking on average of between 9 - 12 hours to collect a container from the terminal. Some containers may incur storage as transporters will not be able to uplift within the free storage period. Unfortunately this is beyond our control.

These delays are expected to continue over the next few days until the NAVIS system is fully operational.

Japan Update

Affected ports and airports are operating at more efficient levels. Some airlines are conducting radiation pre-screening. Export volumes are expected to continue at reduced levels over the coming months.
