Durban Windbound

Strong winds have forced the suspension of operations at both Durban Container Terminal and Pier No 1. Work will only be resumed when winds moderate sufficiently to permit safe container operations.

The South African Weather Service is forecasting strong North-easterly winds over the city for the next few days, which could lead to further disruptions at the port.

Import clients in particular should take note that delays in the discharge, collection and delivery of containers at Durban are expected in the days ahead.

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
