Duty changes today

The following is a summary of duty changes introduced today:

1. The duty on spades and shovels with a width between 150mm and 200mm has been increased to 20%.
2. Anti-dumping duties have been imposed on stainless steel sinks originating in China or Malaysia. These range from 10,84% to 95,86% depending on the manufacturer.
3. The schedule 3 rebate provision for demineralised whey powder used in the manufacture of prepared infant foods has been made retroactive to 1 April 2006. Importers of this product should contact their nearest Safcor Panalpina office regarding possible duty refunds.
4. A temporary rebate facility has been created for capsicums imported for the extraction of oleoresins used in the food industry.
5. A provisional payment at 12,12% of value has been introduced pending the outcome of an anti-dumping investigation into Chinese-made staple fibres of polyester, not carded or combed or prepared for spinning manufactured by Zhe Jiang Waysun. For all other Chinese manufacturers, excluding only Cixi Jiangnan, Nantong Sanjia and Ningbo Dafa, the rate is 122,97%
