Exports to Australia, New Zealand and Oceania

Maersk Line has announced that it will cease accepting dry export cargo from Southern Africa to Oceania from 1st August 2010.

This cessation of service affects container exports to the following destinations:

American Samoa

Australia

Fiji Islands

French Polynesia

New Zealand

Papua New Guinea

Samoa

Vanuatu

The line says that this decision has been taken because of growing container shortages and high demand for this type of equipment in the Far East.

Refrigerated ("reefer") consignments are not affected by this decision and will continue to be accepted by this carrier.
