### French Ports Strikebound

The port at Le Havre was reported to be at a “standstill” yesterday (Wednesday 12th January) as dockworkers protested against government plans to alter working and pension conditions despite an agreement reached last year.

Strike action at both Le Havre and Fos (Marseilles) is to continue until at least Monday 17th January. Union leaders have warned that action may continue after this date if a settlement is not reached, saying that they are prepared to “block the (French) economy”.

Clients routing traffic via these ports are warned of possible delays and additional costs to cargoes currently in transit.
