### Gauteng/Durban Rail Delays

The rail link between Gauteng and Durban had to be closed last night following a derailment near Dannhauser.

Although one of the two tracks is due to be re-opened this morning, delays in the movement of rail import and export traffic between Gauteng and Durban are expected to ensue.

Delays are likely to be worsened by strong north-easterly winds forecast for the Durban region this afternoon and tonight, which could result in a cessation of container handling in the port.
