### IRCC rules to be gazetted

Today's edition of Business Day quotes the Department of Trade and Industry as saying that a new list of clothing industry items that qualify exporters for Import Rebate Credit Certificates will be published shortly. According to the report the list will comprise just ten items, all of which are manufacturing inputs.

The IRCC system was introduced as a temporary support measure for the clothing and textile industries. It was suspended in December 2008 amid fears that it was being abused and that it contravened WTO trade rules.

This new list will apparently enable certificate holders to redeem these prior to the IRCC system becoming redundant on 31st March this year.
