MIDP Extension

ITAC has extended the validity of all existing rebate permits under tariff item 317.04 that expire on 31st December 2010 by 24 months. The new expiry date is 31st December 2012. Holders of existing certificates are not required to submit renewal applications.

Botswana Vehicle Imports

Botswana's revenue authorities have introduced an additional clearing requirement for used vehicles imported into that country: clearance at border posts into Botswana may only take place during normal office hours on weekdays (excluding public holidays). This requirement does NOT apply to vehicles sourced in the South African domestic market or those driven by arriving tourists or other visitors - only to those imported from outside of the SACU.
