More Durban Delays

Durban's Pier No 1 is badly congested by trucks waiting to collect cargo. Strong winds associated with the current cold weather have intermittently shut the port over the past 36 hours. Trucks turned away from the port yesterday because of wind and congestion have not yet been recalled.

We do not expect a quick resolution of the problem: gale-force winds are expected to continue in the area until Friday and the current delays are likely to worsen.
