Nhava Sheva Congestion Surcharge

The Indian port of Nhava Sheva at Mumbai is experiencing severe congestion once more, with all three container terminals at the port being clogged by delayed imports.

Nhava Sheva is India's largest port: Indian ports generally have reported an upswing of 21% in container volumes for March and April this year.

Some carriers have begun diverting traffic away from Nhava Sheva while MSC has introduced a \$50/TEU Port Congestion Surcharge with immediate effect.

Other carriers are reported to be weighing their options.
