SAA Letter of Authority

South African Airways is updating its database and is calling for new Letters of Authority from all importers who use the airline or its facilities authorising Safcor Panalpina to collect documents, clear cargo and to take delivery on their behalf. This is required when cargo is received on a "straight" or airline waybill issued by SAA or one of its partners.

All existing letters of authority will become void from 31st August 2011. This is a separate authorisation to that required for OR Tambo airport.

Letters must be on the importer's letterhead paper and should follow the format suggested below:

Clients are urged to produce these letters and deliver them to Safcor Panalpina at the earliest opportunity: without them we will be unable to collect or clear affected cargo from the end of this month.

Shanghai, Ningbo Delays

Lengthy delays are currently being experienced at both Shanghai and Ningbo in the wake of typhoon Muifa. Both ports were affected by the typhoon which crossed the Chinese coastline last weekend with sustained high winds and heavy rains.

Sao Paulo, Brazil Load Limits

One of the major runways at Guarulhos Airport is to be closed for repairs until year's end. This will reduce the cargo carrying capacity of flights to and from Sao Paulo. Safcor Panalpina's extensive overseas network will be utilised to re-route cargo via the USA where necessary.
