SARS Modernisation Roll-out

Phase 2 of SARS' modernisation process is being rolled out to their operations at Richards Bay, King Shaka International Airport Durban, Port Elizabeth International Airport, East London and Cape Town International Airport this weekend.

The system is expected to be up and running on Sunday 21 August. Minor delays at the affected ports and airports are likely in the week ahead as personnel become accustomed to new/upgraded processes relating to the change.

SARS has made alternative arrangements for the release of urgent consignments during the upgrade period. The roll-out is thus not expected to have any negative impact on clients' cargo movements.

All systems are expected to have returned to routine operation by Monday 22 August.
