### **Safmarine Emergency Risk Surcharges**

Safmarine has announced an increase in the piracy surcharge applicable to cargoes transiting the north-west Indian Ocean on its MESA service. The revised surcharge will apply from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2011 to all cargoes carried on this route. The revised surcharge is US \$140/TEU.

### **Durban Windbound and Weather Warning**

Durban's container terminal has been windbound since early this morning. Only limited landside operations are taking place; the strong winds currently being experienced are expected to persist for the rest of the day.

Moderate to heavy snowfalls are predicted for tonight over Lesotho, the Eastern Free State and the Mpumalanga Highveld. Heavy rainfalls along the coast, treacherous driving conditions and possible road closures may also further delay road deliveries to inland clients over the next 24-48 hours.
