Transnet strike update #15

Details of Transnet recovery operations and staffing situation issued yesterday afternoon are attached for your information. 2615 containers are planned for removal from the Durban terminal today and tomorrow.

Dear Valued Customer / Stakeholder,

National Industrial Action – Update

Overall Transnet attendance levels remain at 60% plus with some areas, particularly the two container terminals in Durban (DCT & Pier 1), being far more seriously affected than other areas.

The level of operations at DCT and Pier 1 is, however, showing steady improvement and numerous recovery interventions are in place. The focus at DCT over the next 72 hours is the removal of import containers from the terminal in order to create space in the stacking area. As at 12h00 today more than 100 containers per hour are exiting the gate via road and the gate will remain open on a 24/7 basis for the collection of import containers. In addition, we have containers exiting via rail and have 3200 trans-shipment containers in stack that are to be loaded onto vessels presently on berth.

We hope to open the first export stacks by the weekend – advice of these details will be communicated in the normal manner.

Please continue to contact our strike command centres for any specific operational queries that you may have – these centres will remain operational until operations are normalised and the backlog eliminated.
