Transnet strike update #2

Ongoing wage negotiations between Transnet and its two largest employee unions are understood to have deadlocked once more.

A strike has been called to start on Monday May 10th, which has the potential to bring South African ports to a virtual standstill.

Some carriers have indicated that they will have their ships leave port ahead of any strike action and await events in the ports' anchorages.
