Transnet strike update #6 : Far East Seafreight

Members of UTATU and SARHWU are reported to have rejected Transnet's latest wage offer and have joined the strike. This will add to delays and backlogs.

Many Far Eastern ports and shipping lines are still taking cargo bookings for cargo destined for South African ports, but prolonged strike action could see more lines refusing bookings.
