#### Transnet Strike

Industry sources have today warned that backlogs arising from this dispute could take up to 12 weeks to clear even if a settlement is achieved at this afternoon's talks between Transnet and Union representatives.

#### British Airways Strike

British Airways cabin crews are to engage in strike action from 24th to 29th May.

According to the airline this will affect flights to and from Heathrow Airport, London, only. This carrier expects to maintain 60% of its scheduled services worldwide during the strike and is apparently confident of maintaining 90% of scheduled services to/from South Africa.

Our partners will endeavour to make sure that all airfreight cargoes using this airline move as booked or are transferred to alternative carriers where applicable.
