Update on Situation in Japan

There will be considerable delays with the import and export of cargo to and from the North Eastern areas of Japan. Congestion at airlines and ports is being experienced. Fuel and truck shortages are hampering the movement of cargo but improving slightly as the one refinery has resumed operations, albeit at a lower level of output. Export volumes have declined and this is expected to continue as a result of damaged production facilities.
