Urgent Application for Changes in Customs Duty : Monitors

ITAC has published an urgent application in Government Gazette 33762 on 19th November for a revision of the duties applicable to monitors of tariff heading 8525.5.

The application seeks to make monitors of a screen size not exceeding 45cm x 45 cm duty free and also those of a screen size exceeding 3m x 4m, while those with a screen size exceeding 45cm x 45cm, but not exceeding 3m x 4m will bear a duty of 25%.
