### **1. Volcano shuts airports**

A cloud of ash from an erupting Icelandic volcano has forced the closure of all Irish and UK airspace and airports as an air safety precaution. Airports are expected to remain closed until at least 6pm local UK time today. Flights throughout Western Europe have been affected by this phenomenon, which will result in delayed cargo movements.

### **2. Airfreight Fuel Surcharge**

Continued strength in world oil prices has resulted in airlines increasing their fuel surcharges. Freight moving on Panalpina controlled charter flights will be surcharged by €0.65/Kg from 23rd April, an increase of €0,05/Kg.
